

Amnesty for explosive goods

Call 114 14 to get the police to collect the goods

Between 15 October 2018 and 11 January 2019 there will be an amnesty for explosive goods in Sweden. During this period anyone handling explosive goods without a licence for them may contact the police, who will collect them from where they are being kept.

Anyone who contacts the police voluntarily during the amnesty will not be charged with illegal handling, and has the right to remain anonymous. To avoid the risk of a charge, it is a condition that the police takes care of the explosive goods.

What is meant by explosive goods?

Examples of explosive goods are hand grenades, explosive substances, igniters, gunpowder and pyrotechnical items.

Call 114 14 to ask the police to collect the goods safely. It is not permitted to bring explosive goods to the police station! Besides, it is dangerous to move explosive goods.
