**Information on personal data**

When receiving a notification to operate a hotel or guest house business, the Swedish Police Authority processes the personal data submitted in e-services, forms and online forms at [polisen.se](https://polisen.se) in accordance with the provisions of the EU General Data Protection Regulation and other applicable data protection regulation. The personal data is processed as part of our exercise of authority and to carry out the tasks stipulated in the Act (2024:1082) on hotel and guesthouse operations. The data is saved for the time being.

Documents submitted to the Swedish Police Authority are generally regarded as public documents which are registered and saved pursuant to the Public Access to Information and Secrecy Act (2009:400) and archiving legislation. If someone requests access to a public document, the information may therefore be disclosed in accordance with the principle of public access to official documents.
