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## Information on personal data processing in connection with the application

When receiving an application for a permit for a concert/music event, the Swedish Police Authority processes the personal data submitted in e-services, forms and online forms at polisen.se in accordance with the provisions of the EU General Data Protection Regulation and other applicable data protection regulation. The personal data you provide in an application is processed as part of our exercise of authority and to carry out the tasks stipulated in the Public Order Act (1993:1617) and in local provisions. The purpose of the processing is to manage your application. The data is saved for the time being, but for no longer than 5 years.

Documents submitted to the Swedish Police Authority are generally regarded as public documents which are registered and saved pursuant to the Public Access to Information and Secrecy Act (2009:400) and archiving legislation. If someone requests access to a public document, the information may therefore be disclosed in accordance with the principle of public access to official documents.

# INFORMATION

According to Chapter 3, Section 7 of the Public Order Act (1993:1617), pyrotechnic products may not be used without a permit from the Swedish Police Authority, if their use, in view of the time, location of the site and other circumstances, entails a risk of injury or damage or considerable inconvenience to any person or property. Chapter 2, Section 20 of the Public Order Act specifies that pyrotechnic products may not be used without a permit from the Swedish Police Authority at a public gathering or public event held indoors. However, if it can be done without compromising order and safety, the Swedish Police Authority may release the organizer from the obligation to apply for a permit.

In accordance with Chapter 2, Section 16 of the Public Order Act, the organizer is primarily responsible for proper order at the gathering or event. This means that the organizer is also responsible for any fireworks, stage fireworks or other pyrotechnics being used in a secure and safe manner. If the organizer appoints a specific person to be responsible for pyrotechnic products, there is nevertheless a responsibility for the organizer to ensure that such a person possesses the competence required for the task.
